I had no idea how much cancer treatment would take over my life. I am in excellent physical shape from years of daily exercise so my Doctors have been very aggressive. They followed a round of chemo/radiation with major surgery, but during the procedure they found the cancer had spread. They gave me time to recover then more tests. Afterwards my cancer was revised to stage 4. I am now on another aggressive chemotherapy regiment.

Amazing Grace Children's Home in Mexico City

I just returned from AGCH. We have 21 children who are 10 or under, 13 of those are 2 to 7 years old! The rest of the children mostly range between 11 and 13. The younger the children the more staff time is needed to care for them so please pray for our staff as they work with these children who would be homeless except for God's provision of AGCH. We currently have three in college. One preparing to be a missions medical Doctor. He was at the top of his class this semester. One is preparing to serve God as a dentist (2nd in her class). We also have one working for a law degree to help us in our work which always involves legal hurdles.

India

When I was diagnosed with cancer we were two weeks from a trip to India. I had to postpone. There is great need and God has provided workers who are prepared to reach the homeless. It is estimated there are 16 million homeless children in India. I plan to renew our work there.
